SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS FOR TRUCK DRIVERS

The Mayor of Revin (Ardennes) insistently reminds all truck drivers who take the road 988 to be extremely watchful and to scrupulously respect the traffic law, especially in the slope of the Mazures Hill.

This sinuous road section has been the site of many road accidents and is located inside a forest particularly rugged with:

- -a 7% down slope,
- -13 curves on 3 kms,
- -a long down slope, including in a built-up area lined with houses and close to a school.



Every day, several hundreds of trucks take this down slope that ends up in the town of Revin.

Drivers must absolutely slow down on this road section that is limited to 50 kmph, without soliciting the brakes, in order to avoid an overheating of the braking system, especially when the vehicles are heavily loaded.

A special distress lane has been set up at the entrance of the town, whose aim is to stop the vehicles in trouble following the break of their braking system.
